DAA F3 is suitable for use as approved by excise authority and requires an Australian Taxation Office (ATO) license to transact.

Absolute Ethanol denatured with Methanol 2%.

A clear, colourless liquid miscible in water and hydrocarbon solvents.

Cleaner odour than DAA Industrial.

Used in specialised formulations, coatings and food packaging.
