Easy to use...

1. If required, prepare surface with Diggers Timber Cleaner (oxalic acid).
2. When using Raw or Pale Boiled Linseed Oil mix 50/50 with Diggers Mineral Turpentine (try the low odour Mineral Turpentine alternative). Anti-Mould and Sprayable Linseed Oil are ready to use.
3. Apply with a brush or lint free cloth. Remove any excess with a lint free cloth to avoid a sticky surface. Excess linseed oil on the surface will form a film which prevents the oil from drying completely.
